

Using the Revision Assistant Libraries

Our <u>Signal Check</u>, <u>Spot Check</u>, and <u>Expansion Pack</u> libraries were expertly designed to fit together like books in a series. Below is one of many potential nine-week roadmaps for teachers using all three libraries. Week 1: Pretest

Give a pretest using a <u>Spot Check</u> to get a baseline for students' scores.

Week 2: Preparation

Prepare students for Assignment 1 by annotating <u>Expansion Pack</u> prompts and <u>Exemplars</u> for key elements.

Week 3: Formative Assignment Give Signal Check Assignment 1.

Week 4: Skill Building

Use the <u>Assignment Report</u> to see where students struggled on Assignment 1. Use Expansion Pack, Signal Check, and Exemplar <u>activities</u> aimed at improving weaker areas.

Week 5: Formative Assignment Give Signal Check Assignment 2.

Week 6: Skill Building

Use Expansion Pack, Signal Check, and Exemplar activities to improve weaker areas from both assignments.

Week 7: Formative Assignment Give Signal Check Assignment 3.

Week 8: Skill Solidifying

Use Expansion Pack, Signal Check, and Exemplar activities aimed at improving remaining weak areas from the assignments.

Week 9: Summative Assignment
Give a summative assignment using
a Spot Check to see students' progress.
